SHARING SESSION BY WORLD-RENOWNED ARTIST D.M. CHERINA IN COLLABORATION WITH TZU CHI HUMANISTIC YOUTH CENTRE

SINGAPORE, 3 DECEMBER 2021: In collaboration with world-renowned sculptor and painter <u>Drago Marin Cherina</u>, Tzu Chi Humanistic Youth Centre (HYC) would like to cordially invite you to attend his sharing session with young artists, who have partnered with Tzu Chi HYC for the past two years, regarding his latest exhibition "The Merlion Story".

The exhibition is currently running at Tzu Chi HYC from 30 November 2021 to 25 December 2021 and is one which aims to raise awareness of the real, clear and lasting danger to the very existence of mankind. It will consist of 22 colourful paintings which will deal with the COVID-19 pandemic oriented through the art of awareness and educational documents of a purely historic nature.

Due to the pandemic, D.M. Cherina has been stuck in Singapore for more than a year after initially only entering the country for transit purposes last year. During this time, the 72-year-old has not stopped his work, thus culminating in "The Merlion Story" exhibition. He hopes to be able to share his thoughts and experiences with the younger generation through this sharing session.


